Advair 250/50mcg	1BID
Proair HFA	1q6h prn
HCTZ 25mg	QD
Allopurinol 300mg	QD

Pertinent Vitals: BP 135/84

Pertinent labs: uric acid 6.2

PMH: COPD (CAT score 8), hypertension, gout

SH: Former smoker – 1 PPD x 10 yrs. and quit 5 yrs. ago

Immunizations: History not available
